Dear Parent/Guardian

In Season 3 2019, weekly Sport will continue at McCarthy on Thursdays during Period 5 and 6. All School Sport and Representative Sport will run together. Season 3 will be starting on the 5 September 2019 and concluding on the 12 December 2019.

Year 7 students will be involved in a four week block rotation of Ice skating, Bowling and a Swim Course. The group who will participate in Learn to Swim, or swimming and development lessons at Nepean Aquatic Centres will be led by qualified swimming instructors and supported by our teachers. They will finish each lesson with water-based games for skill development.

Years 8, 9 and 10 students have selected 3 possible sports for Season 3 and we will allocate one of their preferences to attend for Season 3. This allocation will be based on handing their sport preferences in on time and the available spots in the sports. Therefore, students need to complete the sport form as soon as possible, to ensure their spot is secured. Sports will only run if the required numbers are met, otherwise students will be given another sport of their selected choice. Once their sport preference is chosen and a permission note is returned to their homeroom teacher, students will **NOT** be allowed to change sports. Please also be aware that if your child is to attend Cables, an additional disclaimer form will be given to your child, which must also be completed, signed and returned. If this disclaimer is not completed for Cables, then the student <u>cannot</u> attend this venue, they will remain at school and/or be given another alternative sport which may not be their preferred choice.

Years 7 - 10 Rep Sports Students will trial in weeks 6 and 7 of Term 3 for Cricket, Oz Tag and Girls Basketball. Students who are successful in trials will begin playing in Week 8. Students who are unsuccessful will be placed into another one of the sport choices that they have selected initially with the rest of Year 7 -10.

We have attached a list of sports together with the venue they will be held at to help assist families and organisation. Students will be transported to the venue by bus, unless it is stated that the sport will take place at school. It must be noted that students **WILL NOT** be dismissed from any venues regardless of a parent note. However in an emergency situation, a parent will meet the teacher at the venue and sign out their child.

Buses will take students to and from the venues, leaving during lunchtime or at the start of Period 5, Buses will return to the College by 3:00pm in time for normal afternoon dismissal.

Students will wear full Sports Uniform to school every Thursday. Any students not in the correct Sports Uniform (information in the student's diary) on a Thursday will not be allowed to attend sport on this day.

The cost for students has been included in the School Fees.
